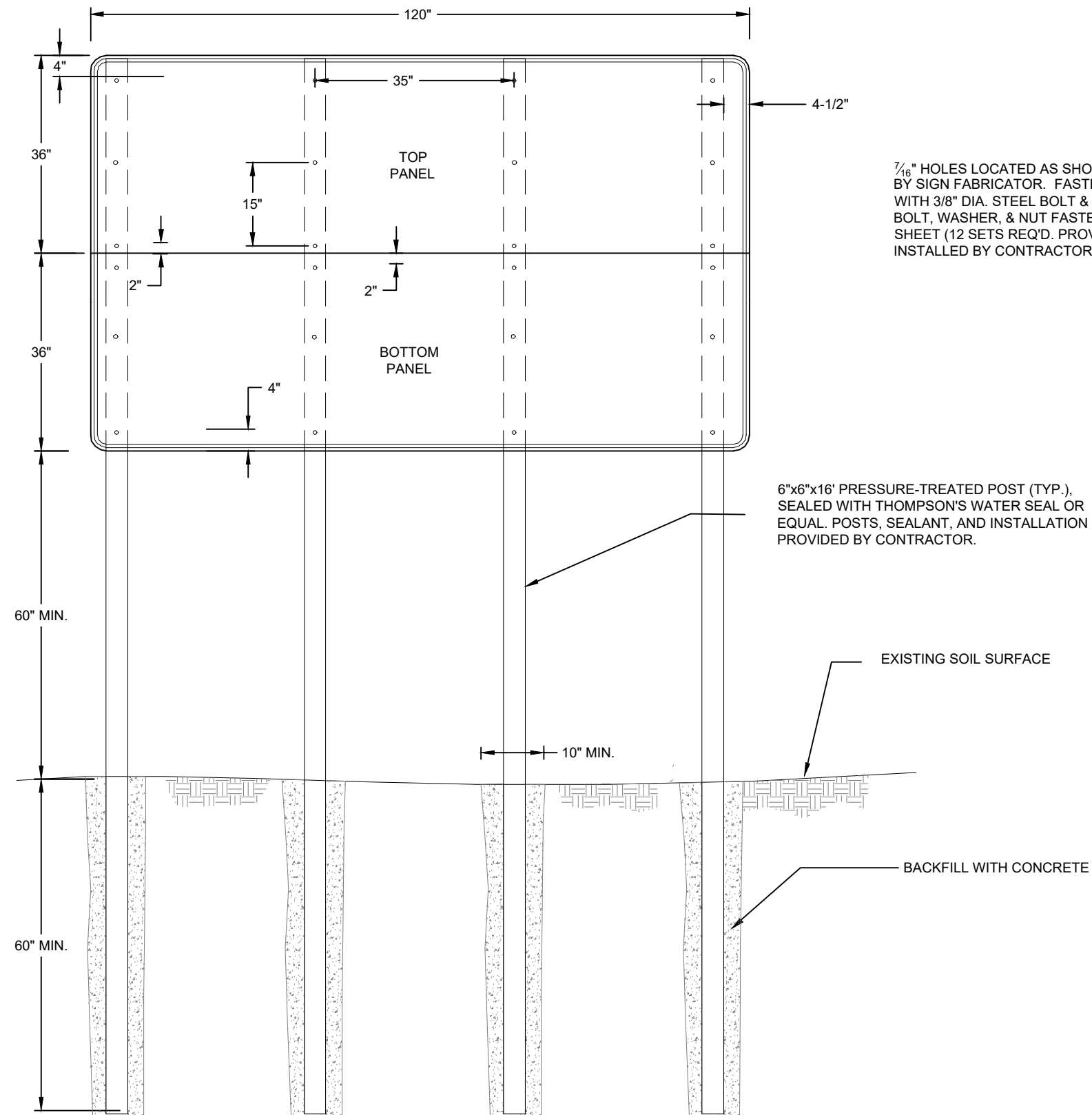

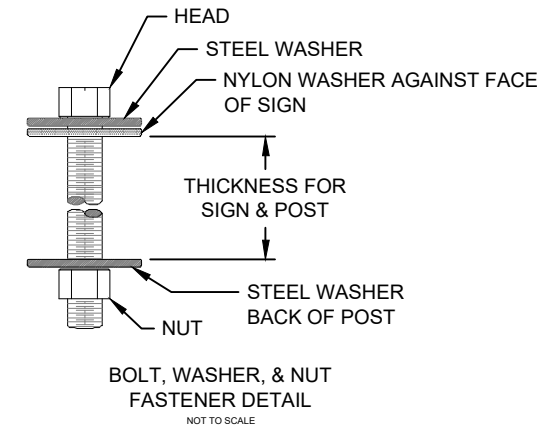

Tracy Blocker, Division of Soil Conservation and Water Quality (Division) opened the meeting.

A) Introductions

- Sara Smith, Engineer with Division
- Brandon Short, P.E., Bolton & Menk Inc

- There are 3 projects being bid at this time, including this one, one in Wright County and one in Chickasaw County.

- This wetland project is part of the Water Quality Initiative that is being used to help implement the Iowa Nutrient Reduction Strategy.

B) Bidding

1. Time of Completion:

- The final date for completion of all work except for seeding is set for **06/15/2027**.
The final date for completion of seeding is **Buffer 06/30/2027 and the Structure 09/15/2027**

2. Liquidated Damages:

- There are liquidated damages provisions - absent a No-Fault Extension
- If *all work except for seeding* is not completed by June 15, 2027, **\$175 per day**.
- If the *seeding* is not subsequently completed by the respective dates **\$125 per day**.
Buffer 06/30/2027 and the Structure 09/15/2027

3. Taxes:

- There is no sales tax for materials purchased
- This should be considered when determining the unit prices submitted in the bid

4. Measurement and Payment:

- The specifications describe the method to be used in measuring and calculating the payment quantities
- Payments will be made based on monthly estimates at 97% of the work completed
- Mobilization is paid as percentage completed of the lump sum (less retainage)
- 97% of the cost of materials stored on site can be paid by submitted an invoice

5. Method of Bidding:

- This is a unit price contract
- Prices shall cover complete work and include all costs incidental thereto unless otherwise indicated

C) Engineer's Discussion:

1. Brandon Short, PE from Bolton & Menk (B&M) provided the following project overview:
 - A.02
 - An existing tile main runs through the site from southwest to northeast. Laterals come from the west, northwest, north, and southeast. All tiles will be removed under the pool. Those from the southwest and west will be daylighted, the one from the southeast will be re-routed, and the two from the north will be left intact but most of the flow will be directed to the wetland.
 - The wetland pool will be excavated.
 - A.03
 - This shows the existing tiles and those that will be removed with the project. The landowner indicated there is a tile intake south of the north-south easement line, on the tile main. There is a tile that connects to the main at that location and comes from the northwest up the hill. This tile will need to be daylighted as well.
 - See the notes on this page for removal lengths and intervals.
 - B.02: Everything on this sheet (except the cover berm) is included in the outlet structure bid item. Another sheet will be added by addendum to show the inlet structure.
 - D.01: All excavated material will be placed in the spoil pile areas, meeting the requirements listed on this sheet.
 - K.01: Seeding areas are approximate, and the actual disturbed area will be seeded and paid for. The pool is not seeded.
 - M.01: 15" Dual-Wall CPDT may be plowed-in lined corrugated plastic pipe or it may be dual wall sticks.
 - M.02
 - 15" Dual-Wall CPDT may be plowed-in lined corrugated plastic pipe or it may be dual wall sticks.
 - 12" Dual-Wall HDPE must be sticks (N-12 or equal) with F-2 rock bedding. It may not be plowed due to bury depth. **This was mis-stated during the meeting.**
 - SUDAS F-2 bedding is to the top of the pipe

- SUDAS R-1 bedding is to the springline
- The cover berm and filling of the low area is paid under the earthfill item.
- M.03: Alignment turn can be achieved with a precast elbow or through flexing the joints if that is achievable.
