INTRODUCTION

Department of Health and Human Services (Agency) is seeking a qualified individual or entity (Service Provider) to provide on-duty and on-call medical and psychiatric services to the Cherokee Mental Health Institute after normal business hours, weekends, and State-paid holidays. The Agency anticipates that the term of any resulting contract will be one (1) year, with two (2) – one (1) year renewal options, beginning 9/30/2025.

Bidders interested in providing these services should submit proposals to the Cherokee Mental Health Institute by email to CHEMHIPurchasing@hhs.iowa.gov no later than 2:00 PM Central Time on 9/15/2025. Any proposals received after this deadline will be rejected. Proposals and any other communications shall not be delivered in person.

Proposals should include the Bidder's cost proposal and sufficient information regarding the Bidder's ability to perform the services sought to enable the Agency to make a judgement about the Bidder's ability to perform the work identified in the Scope of Services.

RESTRICTION ON COMMUNICATION

From the date of issuance of this Request for Bid until the announcement of the successful bidder, Bidders may not contact any employee of the State of Iowa other than the identified contact person about this solicitation. Written responses to all questions received will be provided to all potential Bidders. If a Bidder or someone acting on a Bidder's behalf attempts to discuss this Request for Bid orally or in writing with any members of the evaluation committee, or any employee of the State of Iowa, other than Katelyn Meyers the Bidder may be disqualified.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

The successful Bidder will provide on-duty and on-call medical services to the Cherokee Mental Health Institute after normal business hours, weekends, and State-paid holidays. The Cherokee Mental Health Institute is located at 1251 West Cedar Loop, Cherokee, Iowa 51012. Coverage will be intermittent and scheduled in advance. Week night coverage is typically 4:30 PM to 8:00 AM on the following day, Monday through Friday. Weekend coverage is typically from 4:30 PM Friday through 8:00 AM Monday. State-paid holiday coverage is typically 4:30 PM on the day preceding the holiday to 8:00 AM on the day following the holiday. The successful Bidder must be licensed as a Physician Assistant with at least one year of relevant training and/or experience in psychiatric care or be a licensed Psychiatric Nurse Practitioner in accordance with the State of Iowa requirements.

During periods of coverage, the successful Bidder will:

- 1. Be available by telephone within five (5) minutes of being called by an on-duty employee,
- 2. Be available in person within twenty (20) minutes of being called by an on-duty employee when, based on accepted medical practice guidelines, it is determined that immediate medical attention is required.
 - a. The successful Bidder will not be required to remain physically present on campus for the duration of scheduled on-call periods of coverage as long as the telephone and in person time standards can be met. Limited accommodations are available on campus.



- 3. Provide medical and psychiatric support services,
- 4. Assure appropriate medical and psychiatric responses are provided when the need arises,
- Collaborate with the Agency's Clinical Director, Medical Director, and/or medical staff regarding the establishment of psychiatric diagnoses for CMHI patients,
- 6. Assist the Agency's staff in the development of care plans related to the patient's psychiatric needs,
- 7. Provide additional assistance and consultation as deemed necessary by the Agency,

EVALUATION CRITERIA

The Agency intends to award this Request for Bid to the Bidder that meets all minimum criteria as outlined in this solicitation at the lowest proposed cost. Please include the following elements, if applicable, in your proposal:

- 1. Hourly rate for on-duty and on-call services, as well as rates for State holidays;
- 2. The capacity of the Bidder to complete the responsibilities described in the Scope of Services;
- 3. Experience and references that demonstrate, to the satisfaction of the Agency, the expertise and ability of the Bidder to provide the Scope of Services described;

NOTICE OF INTENT TO AWARD

Notice of Intent to Award will be sent by email to all Bidders submitting a timely bid proposal no later than 9/16/2025. The Notice of Intent to Award is subject to execution of a written contract and, as a result, does not constitute the formation of a contract between the Agency and apparent successful Bidder.

ACCEPTANCE PERIOD

Negotiation and execution of the contract shall be completed no later than 9/30/2025. If the apparent successful bidder fails to negotiate and execute a contract, in its sole discretion, the Agency may revoke the award and award the contract to the next highest ranked bidder or withdraw the Informal Competitive Solicitation. The Agency further reserves the right to cancel the award at any time prior to the execution of a written contract.



REVIEW OF NOTICE OF DISQUALIFICATION OR NOTICE OF INTENT TO AWARD DECISION

Bidders may request reconsideration of either a notice of disqualification or notice of intent to award decision by submitting a written request to the Agency:

The Agency must receive the written request for reconsideration within five calendar days of the date of either a disqualification notice or a notice of intent to award, exclusive of Saturdays, Sundays, and legal state holidays. The written request may be emailed or delivered by postal service or other shipping service. Do not deliver any requests for reconsideration to the office in person. It is the Bidder's responsibility to ensure that the request for reconsideration is received prior to the deadline. Postmarking or submission to a shipping service by the due date shall not substitute for actual receipt of a request for reconsideration by the Agency.

The request for reconsideration shall clearly and fully identify all issues being contested by reference to the page and section number of the RFP. If a Bidder submitted multiple Proposals and requests that the Agency reconsider a notice of disqualification or notice of intent to award decision for more than one Proposal, a separate written request shall be submitted for each. At the Agency's discretion, requests for reconsideration from the same Bidder may be reviewed separately or combined into one response. The Agency will expeditiously address the request for reconsideration and issue a decision. The Bidder may choose to file an appeal with the Agency within five calendar days of the date of the decision on reconsideration, exclusive of Saturdays, Sundays, and legal state holidays, and in accordance with 441 lowa Admin. Code Ch. 7.
