889 form clarification

The Department of Public Defense is making the following changes to the Procurement Timetable as referenced on the RFP Cover Sheet.

889 Representation Form - – The Bidder shall complete, sign, and submit the document included as **Attachment**

#10 to this RFP, indicating whether or not it uses any of the prohibited telecommunications or video surveillance equipment or services as a substantial or essential component of any system within Bidder's business.

Section 889 Part B of the FY 2019 National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) went into effect August 13, 2020.

The legislation was passed to combat national security and intellectual property threats that face the United

States and contains two prohibitions: Part A and Part B.

As a recipient of federal funds, this rule applies to the Iowa Department of Public Defense and all vendors

14(c)(1) and (2) please place a check mark in the box "does not" if you do not provide chinese company telecom equipment to the government and also the second one if you do not use yourself. (banned companies are as follows: Huawei Technologies Company or ZTE Corporation (or any subsidiary or affiliate of such entities, Hytera Communications Corporation, Hangzhou Hikvision Digital Technology Company, or Dahua Technology Company)
