



Consent to Assignment Agreement

This Consent to Assignment Agreement (the “**Consent**”), is entered into as of the date of last signature written below (the “**Consent Effective Date**”) by and among Cisco Systems, Inc. (“**Cisco**”), a Delaware corporation, having a place of business at 170 West Tasman Drive, San Jose, California 95134, United States, the State of Iowa Department of Administrative Services (DAS) (“**Assignor**”), a State Government Agency formed under the laws of Iowa having its principal place of business at 1305 E. Walnut St., Des Moines, IA, 50319, United States, and the State of Iowa Department of Management (DOM) (“**Assignee**”), a State Government Agency formed under the laws of Iowa having its principal place of business at 1007 E. Grand Avenue G13, Des Moines, Iowa 50319, United States.

Cisco and Assignor entered into a(n) NASPO ValuePoint STATE OF IOWA PARTICIPATING ADDENDUM - DATA COMMUNICATIONS PRODUCTS & SERVICES (2019-2026) dated April 1, 2021, as may have been amended (the “**Participating Addendum**”);

Assignor desires to assign, novate and transfer to Assignee all rights and obligations of Assignor under the Agreement for the purchase of products and/or services as of the Assignment Date defined below.

In consideration of the covenants and promises contained herein and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is expressly acknowledged by all parties to this Consent, the parties agree as follows:

1. Effective as of October 01, 2025 (“**Assignment Date**”), except as set forth below, Assignor hereby assigns and transfers to Assignee, pursuant to the Agreement, all rights and obligations of Assignor under the Agreement for the purchase or products and/or services. Such assignment shall apply on a going forward basis for all orders placed on or after the Assignment Date.
2. All existing obligations and responsibilities of Assignor under the Agreement for orders placed by Assignor with Cisco prior to the Assignment Date shall remain with Assignor. All orders under the Agreement for business after the Assignment Date shall be placed only by Assignee and Assignee will assume all responsibility for the Agreement going forward.
3. Nothing herein shall contain a waiver of any rights that Cisco or Assignor may have against the other as a result of any failure to perform or default under the terms of the Agreement which failure or default occurred prior to the Assignment Date.
4. All of the covenants and agrees contained herein shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective representatives, successors and assigns.
5. This Consent may be executed in counterparts, all of which, when taken together, shall constitute one and the same Consent.
6. Any dispute in the meaning, effect or validity of this Consent will be resolved in accordance with the terms of the Agreement. If any provision of this Consent is held to be illegal or unenforceable, that provision will be limited or eliminated to the minimum extent necessary so that this Consent will otherwise remain in full force and effect and enforceable so as to give effect to the intent of the parties hereunder.
7. Unless otherwise defined in this Consent, all terms capitalized but not otherwise defined in this Consent shall have the meanings given to them in the Agreement.
8. This Consent constitutes the entire agreement among the parties concerning the subject matter of this Consent and replaces any prior oral or written communications between the parties, all of which are excluded. There are no conditions, understandings, agreements, representations or warranties, expressed or implied, that are not specified herein. This Consent may be modified only by a written document executed by the parties hereto.

The parties have caused this Consent to be duly executed effective as of the Consent Effective Date. Each party represents that its respective signatories whose signatures appear below have been and are on the date of signature duly authorized to execute this Consent.
