Definitions

- Channel: Use case (Call Center, IAL2, Login, etc.)
- Flow: Different product configurations. For example, you could have the full identity verification flow (doc auth, liveness, face match) vs. just document authentication.
- Single Sign-on (SSO): SSO integration allows for connection to an IAM (Identity and Access Management) provider of choice and the use of an individual's corporate credentials when accessing the IDVerse enterprise portal rather than maintaining a separate login specific to each environment. It can also support the creation of accounts in the portal using Just in Time provisioning with the appropriate role and channel access configurations.
- URL Masking: provides the option for making the AWS Instance appear to be hosted as part of a Customer's or Client's own web infrastructure and not as an externally provided service.
