

**REQUEST FOR QUOTES (RFQ)  
for  
Copeland IHAP Prescribed Fire  
20CRDWBBHICK-0053**

The Department of Natural Resources (DNR) is seeking a Service Provider to complete 20.97 acres of prescribed fire on the Copeland site enrolled in the Iowa Habitat and Access Program (IHAP) for the purpose of native grass maintenance. DNR anticipates that the term of any resulting contract will be October 7, 2019 through August 1, 2020. **Service Providers may not contact any employee of the State of Iowa about this Informal RFP other than the DNR Issuing Officer:**

If a Service Provider or someone acting on a Service Provider’s behalf attempts to discuss this RFQ orally or in writing with any members of the DNR, any employee of the State of Iowa, or anyone other than the named DNR Issuing Officer, then the Service Provider may be disqualified.

**Submission of Quotes:** Service Providers interested in providing the services described under the “Description of Work and Scope of Services” shall submit quotes to the **DNR Issuing Officer** no later than **3:00 PM** CST on **September 23, 2019**. Any quote received after this deadline shall not be considered.

Only written quotes received via hand delivery, e-mail, fax or hard copy mail using the form labeled “Service Provider Cost Proposal – DNR RFQ #20CRDWBBHICK-0053” included in this RFQ will be accepted.

Service Providers may submit written questions regarding this RFQ and the procurement process to the DNR Issuing Officer at the above address through **3:00 PM** CST on September 19, 2019. Written responses to any questions received will be provided no later than September 20, 2019 to all potential Service Providers via the State of Iowa Bid Opportunities / Hosted Bids website: <http://bidopportunities.iowa.gov/>.

**Description of Work and Scope of Services:** Service Providers that have had a prescribed fire escape in the last 24 months **are not eligible** to receive a prescribed fire contract with the DNR.

**Statement of Work.** Contractor shall perform the following Tasks by the Task Milestone Dates set out in the following table:

<p><b>Task 1:</b> Copeland IHAP Prescribed Fire Spring 2020 – 20.97 Acres</p> <p><b>Description:</b> Contractor shall complete 20.97 acres of prescribed fire in the area outlined in Exhibit A. The entire area is to be burned. Firebreaks can be installed in the Fall of 2019 but fire must be performed between March 1 and April 15, 2020. Contractor is responsible for establishing firebreaks and shall provide the DNR Project Manager with a burn plan in advance to commencing the burn. Notification to County Communications as well as adjoining landowners is required prior to fire ignition.</p>	<p>Firebreaks shall be installed between October 7, 2019 and no later than 48 hours prior to the planned date of the prescribed burn.</p> <p>Prescribed burn shall occur between March 1 and April 15, 2020</p>

**Minimum Qualifications/Equipment Specifications:** The DNR will not evaluate minimum qualifications/equipment specifications but does expect documentation to be provided with the “Service Provider Cost Proposal – DNR RFQ #20CRDWBBHICK-0053”. The following are minimum qualifications required for this project:

- Liability insurance covering damages from escaped fires on adjacent land
- A prescribed burn plan that meets DNR burn plan policy

**Source of Funding:** The source of funding for the Contract entered into from this RFQ is Iowa Wildlife Habitat fees.

**Acceptance of Contract Terms and Conditions:** By submitting a response, each Service Provider acknowledges its acceptance of the terms and conditions of the contract template “DNR Standard Contract Conditions” and “General Conditions” found at <http://www.iowadnr.gov/About-DNR/RFP-Bid-Lettings>.

If a Service Provider takes exception to a contract provision, then the Service Provider must state the specific exception and the reason for the exception, and must attach to its “Service Provider Cost Proposal” the specific contract language it proposes to include as an alternative to the provision. Contract provision exceptions that materially change the terms or the requirements of this informal bidding process may be deemed non-responsive by the DNR, as determined in its sole discretion, resulting in possible disqualification of the Service Provider’s quote. With regard to the “DNR Standard Contract Conditions,” DNR and the successful Service Provider may agree to modifications to the terms of the “DNR Standard Contract Conditions” as necessary to negotiate the terms of a contract. A Service Provider’s failure to state an exception to any contract provision and propose alternative language may be deemed by the DNR to constitute the Service Provider’s acceptance thereof. The State reserves the right to refuse to enter into a contract with the successful Service Provider for any reason, even after delivery of notice of selection or intent to award a contract.

**Additional information:** The costs of preparation and delivery in response to this RFQ are solely the responsibility of the Service Provider.

DNR reserves the right to reject any or all submitted responses, in whole or in part, to advertise a new RFQ, to abandon the need for such RFQ, and to cancel this RFQ opportunity at any time prior to the execution of a written contract.

All information submitted by a Service Provider may be treated as a public record by the DNR.

By submitting a response, a Service Provider agrees that it will not bring any claim or have any cause of action against DNR or the State of Iowa based on any misunderstanding concerning the information provided within this RFQ or concerning the DNR or the State of Iowa’s failure, negligent or otherwise, to provide the Service Provider with pertinent information as intended by this RFQ.

If the apparent successful Service Provider fails to negotiate and deliver an executed contract within a reasonable period of time following selection, then the DNR may, in its sole discretion, cancel the award and award the contract to the next highest ranked Service Provider.

The DNR shall have the sole option to amend the contract resulting from this RFQ for subsequent periods, adding up to no more than six years total from the beginning date of the original contract, by executing a signed amendment prior to the expiration of the original contract.

**Evaluation Criteria:** Quotes will be evaluated and ***the contract awarded to the responsible Service Provider submitting the lowest priced quote.***

**Service Provider Cost Proposal – DNR RFQ #20CRDWBBHICK-0053**

The Service Provider quote shall include an all-inclusive, total cost in U.S. Dollars (including all travel, expenses, etc.) to provide the requested services. All pricing to be FOB Destination, freight cost included; and based on Net 60 Days Payment Terms. All fees expected for payment are to be included in this bid.
