#### CONSTRUCTION/MATERIAL:

- ✖ 18-gauge 300 series stainless steel exterior and 20-gauge interior
- ✖ Base frame made of 16-gauge stainless steel with reinforced cross channels
- ✖ All fasteners are security type
- ✖ All welds are ground and polished

#### HEATING/ELECTRICAL:

- ➔ ✖ Side mount removable heating assembly
  - Snap in with padlock compatible latch
  - 120 volts / 1700 watts / 14.2 Amps
  - NEMA plug 5-15P
- ✖ Stainless steel strain relief on electrical cord. 12-gage cord wrap on heat box
- Heat baffle on floor for heat distribution

#### COMPONENTS:

##### Doors

- Magnetic closure double door, gasketless
- Three heavy-duty 12-gauge stainless steel hinges
- ✖ Drop down padlocking door latch

##### Display

- Solar-powered digital thermometer

##### Insulation

- Fully insulated in top, bottom, and sides with 1" thick high-density fiberglass

#### \* Racks Upgrade to 2 sets of 18 ga stainless steel racks

- Additional removable universal racks for steam pans or sheet pans (optional) meet NSF standards

##### Handles

- Push/pull handle on each side
- Four-sided tubular top rail

- Turns on its own radius on center casters

##### Bumpers
