- A. Prefinished counterflashing (07 6200), finished to match aluminum storefront system, at all storefront locations shall be provided and installed by bid package BP-01 and/or Aluminum-Framed Entrances and Storefronts contractor.

3) QUESTIONS

- A. What bid package is responsible for the site utilities? A> BP-01, see 01 1200 contract summary for bid package information. BP-06 is responsible for electrical and technology.
- B. What bid package is responsible for the landscaping? A> BP-01, see 01 1200 contract summary for bid package information.
- C. What bid package is responsible for the paving, paving sealants, and pavement markings and signage? A> BP-01, see 01 1200 contract summary for bid package information.
- D. Is the ADA button bollard part of the electrical package or the general package? A> All work for the ADA button, pedestal post, and related work shall be provided under the electrical package BP-06
- E. Which package is responsible for the downspout connections? A> Downspout adapters are included in section 07 6310 (BP-02).
- F. Which package is responsible for the transformer pad? A> BP-06, includes all work to supply and install the transformer pad per Mid-America requirements. Which package is responsible for Rock around the transformer? A> Transformer pad and mote are by electrical contractor

(BP-06). 3" river rock adjacent to the transformer mote shall be by BP-01 along with concrete bollards. Contractors to coordinate sequencing of work around transformer area.

- G. Does the \$5,000 allowance in the electrical bid package cover the other contractors' trailer connections? A> The allowance is for Mid-American costs for any temporary power. Electrical contractor is responsible for temporary power beyond Mid-American costs.
- H. Is there any response to the question I had previously about bidding the total project and adding a line to the bid form for that? A> Response in Addendum #02, Dated May 07, 2026.
