Description of Good:

The DNR is seeking annual contract pricing to purchase heavy duty dock components. The quantities will be determined by the needs of the DNR and are not guaranteed. The contract duration will be 1 year with the opportunity of up to 5 annual extensions at the DNR's discretion. Cost negotiations will take place during each renewal. **The cost evaluation will be split into "Heavy Duty" and "Light Weight". This may result in multiple awards, but will not limit the possibility of a sole entity winning both bids. Contractors may bid on an and/or basis.**

Any deviations to the following specifications should be noted next to the specification listed below by either handwriting or inserting a comment next to the specification. The DNR reserves the right to determine if the deviations are acceptable. Vendors must be authorized manufacture representatives authorized to extend manufacturer's warranties.

Insert Specifications

Heavy Duty Large Lake Dock designed to withstand wind, waves, and high use/large boats on Iowa's large lakes.

- Docks should be fully adjustable for varying water levels and available in roll-in, 20 ft lift-in, post mounted sections, or floating configurations.
- Dock should be available in varying widths (4 to 8 feet)
- Decking material must be weather, wear, and impact resistant
- Decking material for roll-in or post mounted configurations must be porous to prevent large waves from lifting the dock
- Dock framing will be constructed from hot-dipped galvanized steel or aluminum
- Welded steel bumper tubes should be placed every 10 feet and covered with plastic, pvc, or other cushioning material
- Quote should include prices for:
 - 6' by 60' (total length) lift in dock (three 20' sections) with ten 5' tall bumper tubes



- 6' by 60' (total length) roll in dock with approach and bumper tubes
- 6' by 30' (total length) roll in dock with approach and bumper tubes
- Individual components:
 - 6' by 20' lift in dock section
 - Approach - price per foot?
 - 5' tall welded bumper tubes
 - Other major components: ___% of MSRP

Light-weight Maintenance Free Dock designed to be installed by park/area managers and requiring minimal maintenance

- Framework should be heavy duty galvanized steel
- Float tanks with a 20 year warranty
- Decking should be maintenance free vinyl, non-slip, and UV/ heat resistant
- There should be no exposed fasteners. Corner bumpers and rub rails should be installed the length of the dock to protect boats.
- Axles/rollers to protect floats from dragging during installation/removal
- Docks should be delivered and initially installed by the vendor.
- Quote should include prices for:
 - Dock sections:
 - 4' by 20', 30'
 - 6' by 30', 40'
 - Approaches
 - 4' by 16', 18'
 - 6' by 10', 20'
 - ADA Compliant railing for approach
 - Spud Poles with auger system to drive them in
 - Tie up cleats.
 - All other parts/tools for assembly and installation: ___% of MSRP.
