ATTACHMENT 1(SPECIFICATIONS)

The Contractor will be responsible for complete snow removal when snow accumulation of more than two (2) inches occurs or when snowfall with blowing conditions has accumulated in drifts of more than two (2) inches that make normal use of the facility difficult. Areas needing serviced include all sidewalks, driveways, parking lots and compound areas as discussed at the site visit.

Salt, sand, bulk snow removal or any additional service requires approval by the State's Authorized Representative.

All areas are to be clear and accessible 7 days a week by Noon the day of accumulation. Facility personnel working hours are 06:30 am to 4:30 pm.

Snow removal will be in such a manner that there will be no loss of parking, roadways or blockage of sidewalk and steps. No snow can be pushed up against fencing or structures. Areas noted with "yellow square" on ATTACHMENT 2 are "No Pilling" areas. Additional "No Piling" may be added after site visits. If there are additional "No Pilling" areas added, ATTACHMENT 2 will be updated accordingly.

Response time: When the snow accumulates two inches or more (as measured by the closest National Weather Service or local airport) or when snowfall with blowing conditions creates drifts of more than two (2) inches, the awarded Contractor should assume that they will need to perform this task unless otherwise directed by the State's Authorized Representative.

Contract will be awarded to Contract with lowest "Per Event" Bid submitted.
Event: A meteorological weather system that produces any type or combination of winter precipitation (ice, snow, hail, sleet, freezing rain, etc.). For billing purposes, 1 event equals one (1) 24 hour period that begins at 12:00 am (midnight) and ends at 11:59pm.
