

**25032 Amendment No. 1**

This Amendment No. 1 (“Amendment”) to Participating Addendum number 25032 (“Agreement”) (leveraging NASPO ValuePoint/State of Utah Master Agreement MA149 (“Master”)), effective September 15, 2020 by and between the State of Iowa, acting by and through the Department of Administrative Services, assigned to the Department of Management (“DOM”) on September 24, 2025 and AT&T Enterprises, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company and successor in interest to AT&T Corp. (“Vendor”), is made, entered into, and effective as of the date of last signature below. This Amendment will remain coterminous with the Agreement.

Section 1: Background.

The following changes to the agreement are necessary due to the assignment of the State of Iowa Participating Addendum 25032 to the Iowa Department of Management (DOM), the Participating Entity.

Section 2: Amendment to the Agreement.

The Amendment modifies, to the extent specified below, the terms and conditions of the Agreement:

Revision 1: Section 3. Authorized Purchasing Entities. Replace “State Chief Procurement Official” with the “Iowa Department of Management”. Authority over IT contracting resides in Iowa Code Chapter 8 and belongs with DOM.

Revision 2: Section 5. Primary Contacts. Replace the Primary Contact for the Participating Entity with ITContracts, 200 E. Grand, Des Moines, IA 50309, 515-672-4569, ITContracts@dom.iowa.gov.

Revision 3: Section 9. Administrative Fee and Reporting: Replace “Iowa Department of Administrative Services”. Send to: State of Iowa- CAS/Central Procurement Enterprise Attention: DAS-CPE COO 1305 E. Walnut St. Des Moines” with “Iowa Department of Management.”

Section 3: Ratification and Authorization.

Except as expressly amended and supplemented herein, the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect, and the parties hereby ratify and confirm the terms and conditions thereof. Each party

to this Amendment represents and warrants that it has the right, power, and authority to enter into and perform its obligations under this Amendment. Each party further affirms that all requisite actions (corporate, statutory, or otherwise) have been taken to approve its execution, delivery, and performance.

Section 4: Execution.

In consideration of the mutual covenants set forth above and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt, adequacy, and legal sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties have entered into this Amendment and have caused their duly authorized representatives to execute it.
