Master Agreement Terms and Conditions:

- Scope: This Participating Addendum ("Addendum") covers the Office Furniture and Related Services (2023-2028) led by the State of Utah for use by state agencies and other entities located in the Participating State authorized by that State's statutes to utilize State contracts with the prior approval of the State's Chief Procurement Official.
- Participation: This Addendum may be used by all state agencies, political subdivisions and other entities authorized by an individual state's statutes to use State of Iowa contracts are subject to the prior approval of the respective State Chief Procurement Official. Issues of interpretation and eligibility for participation are solely within the authority of the State Chief Procurement Official.

Within the State of Iowa, all state agencies, state facilities, cities, counties or education entities or any entity funded in part with state tax dollars, are eligible purchasers and authorized to purchase Products and Services under the terms of this Addendum in lieu of a separate competitive selection process. (Exception: State of Iowa executive branch agencies must purchase according to applicable standards and seek approval from the State of Iowa - Space Management and Leasing Division Administrator when required as directed by administrative code before purchasing from this contract.)

Agencies, political subdivisions, facilities, cities, counties, educational entities, or other entities eligible to purchase Product and Services pursuant to this Addendum are collectively defined herein as "Purchasing Entities."

4. Participating Entity Modifications Or Additions To The Master Agreement These modifications or additions apply only to actions and relationships within the Participating Entity.

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[X] The following changes are modifying or supplementing the Master Agreement terms and conditions.

- a. <u>Pricing:</u> The pricing terms from the NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement MA3963 ("Master Agreement") shall flow down this Addendum. Any adjustment or amendment of the pricing will not be effective unless approved by the Lead State for the Master Agreement. The State of Iowa will be given the immediate benefit of any nationwide published commercial price list decrease.
- b. <u>Services:</u> Contractor shall provide, through their Authorized Dealer network, installation, design, project management, and reconfiguration services (collectively referred to as "Services") to all Purchasing Entities. Services charges for all products offered through this Addendum will negotiated on a project-by-project basis with the Authorized Dealer. Services charges will be included as a line item in the quote provided by the Authorized Dealer.

Contractor shall provide, through its Authorized Dealer network or approved freight carrier(s), liftgate services and other non-standard delivery services which



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are outside of Contractor's standard freight costs, such as palletization, storage, special permits, etc.; should Contractor be able to accommodate the request, these services will be negotiated on a project-by-project basis and approved by the Purchasing Entity. Charges for non-standard delivery services will be included as a line item in the quote provided by the Authorized Dealer.

- c. <u>Contract Effective Dates:</u> This Addendum is effective upon final signature of all parties, and shall be coterminous with Master Agreement.
- d. <u>Non-Exclusivity</u>: Nothing herein is intended nor shall be construed as creating any exclusive arrangement with Contractor. This Contract shall not restrict state and other governmental entities from acquiring similar, equal or like goods and/or services from other contracted entities or sources.
- e. <u>Administrative Fee:</u> Contractor shall pay a 1% administrative fee to the State of Iowa on all sales made within the State of Iowa against this Addendum. The administration fee due to the State of Iowa shall be paid quarterly by Contractor directly to the Participating State, made payable to the "Iowa Department of Administrative Services".

f. Quarterly Usage Reporting Requirement: Quarterly usage reports must be submitted to NASPO ValuePoint and the Master Agreement Administrator. Refer to Attachment A: NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement Terms and Conditions for usage reporting requirements. The initiation and submission of the quarterly reports are the responsibility of the OEM. There will be no prompting or notification provided by the Master Agreement Administrator. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in Master Agreement cancellation. Quarterly reports must coincide with the quarters in the fiscal year as outlined below:

Quarter #1: July 1 through September 30, due annually by October 30 Quarter #2: October 1 through December 31, due annually by January 30 Quarter #3: January 1 through March 31, due annually by April 30.

Quarter #4: April I through June 30, due annually by July 30.

Contractor shall provide an electronic detailed quarterly report on ALL sales made under this Addendum via e-Mail to the lowa Department of Administrative Services, Central Procurement. Attention: Jennifer Zepeda email at Jennifer.zepeda@iowa.gov. The report file format shall be Microsoft Excel compatible format. The report at minimum shall include the date of sale, customer name and address, full product description, SKU Numbers, quantity, invoice number, - product description, product item number, quantity, unit and extended invoices unit and extended invoice prices.



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- g. Payment Terms NET60: Payment for completion of a purchase order is normally made within 30 days following the date the entire order is delivered or the date a correct invoice is received, whichever is later. Payments may be made in installments for phased projects when agreed to by the Contractor and the Purchasing Entity. Payments for completion of an installment or phase of a project shall be made within 30 days following the date of completion of the installation. After 60 days the Contractor may assess overdue account charges up to a maximum rate of one percent per month on the outstanding balance. Payments will be remitted by mail. Payments may be made via a State or political subdivision "Purchasing Card" with no additional charge.
- h. Compliance with the Law; Nondiscrimination in Employment: The Contractor, its employees, agents, and subcontractors shall not engage in discriminatory employment practices which are forbidden by federal or state law, executive orders, and rules of the lowa Department of Administrative Services. The Contractor, its employees, agents, and subcontractors shall comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, rules, ordinances, regulations, orders when performing under the Contract, including without limitation, all laws applicable to the prevention of discrimination in employment (e.g., lowa Code chapter 216 and section 19B.7) and the use of targeted small businesses as subcontractors and suppliers.

Upon the State's written request, as a federal Contractor, Contractor shall submit to the State a copy of its federal affirmative action plan, that conforms to the requirements set forth in Iowa Administrative Code rule 11—121.1(1)"b".

The Contractor, its employees, agents and subcontractors shall also comply with all federal, state, and local laws, including any permitting and licensure requirements, in carrying out the work performed under this Contract.

In the event Contractor contracts with third parties for the performance of any of the Contractor obligations under this Contract, Contractor shall take such steps as necessary to ensure such third parties are bound by the terms and conditions contained in this section.

Notwithstanding anything in this Contract to the contrary, Contractor's failure to fulfill any requirement set forth in this section 4(i) shall be regarded as a material breach of this Contract and the State may cancel, terminate, or suspend, in whole or in part, this Contract. The State may further declare Contractor ineligible for future state contracts in accordance with authorized procedures or the Contractor may be subject to other sanctions as provided by law or rule.

5. <u>Subcontractors</u>: All contractors, dealers, and resellers authorized in the State of Iowa, as shown on the dedicated Contractor (cooperative contract) website, are approved to provide sales and service support to participants under this Addendum. The contractor's dealer participation will be in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the aforementioned Master Agreement.



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- 6. Orders: Any order placed by a Participating Entity or Purchasing Entity for a product and/or service available from this Master Agreement shall be deemed to be a sale under (and governed by the prices and other terms and conditions) of the Master Agreement unless the parties to the order agree in writing that another contract or agreement applies to such order.
 - Purchase Order Instructions: All orders issued should make reference to Master Agreement # MA3963 and State of Iowa Addendum # MA23127.
- 7. Amendment: This Addendum shall not be altered, changed or amended except by instrument in writing executed by the parties hereto and all other required signatories. Notwithstanding the foregoing and except as otherwise may be provided in this Addendum, amendments to the Master Agreement (including but not limited to extensions, renewals, and modifications to the terms, conditions and pricing) will automatically be incorporated into this Addendum without the need to formally amend this Addendum.
