- 1. <u>Scope</u>: This addendum covers the Vehicle Lifts and Garage Associated Equipment led by the State of Washington for use by state agencies and other entities located in the Participating State authorized by that State's statutes to utilize State contracts with the prior approval of the State's Chief Procurement Official.
- 2. <u>Participation</u>: This NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement may be used by all state agencies, institutions of higher institution, political subdivisions and other entities authorized to use statewide contracts in the State of Iowa. Issues of interpretation and eligibility for participation are solely within the authority of the State Chief Procurement Official.

4. PARTICIPATING ENTITY MODIFICATIONS OR ADDITIONS TO THE MASTER

AGREEMENT

These modifications or additions apply only to actions and relationships within the Participating Entity.

[X] The following changes are modifying or supplementing the Master Agreement terms and conditions.

- 5. <u>Lease Agreements</u>: Purchasing Entities who have the authority to enter into a lease will negotiate the terms of the lease with the Contractor.
- 6. <u>Subcontractors</u>: All contractors, dealers, and resellers authorized in the State of Iowa, as shown on the dedicated Contractor (cooperative contract) website, are approved to provide sales and service support to participants in the NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement. The contractor's dealer participation will be in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the aforementioned Master Agreement.
- 7. Orders: Any order placed by a Participating Entity or Purchasing Entity for a product and/or service available from this Master Agreement shall be deemed to be a sale under (and governed by the prices and other terms and conditions) of the Master Agreement unless the parties to the order agree in writing that another contract or agreement applies to such order.
- 8. <u>Payment Terms</u>: Section 7.2 Payment. of Master Contract No. 05316 is modified to state the following:

Payment after Acceptance is normally made within 30 days following the date the entire order is delivered or the date a correct invoice is received, whichever is later. Per Iowa Code § 8A.514 the State of Iowa is allowed sixty (60) days to pay an invoice submitted by a vendor. The State of Iowa shall pay all approved invoices in arrears and in conformance with Iowa Code 8A.514. The State of Iowa may pay in less than sixty (60) days, but an

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election to pay in less than sixty (60) days shall not act as an implied waiver of Iowa Code § 8A.514. Payments may be remitted by mail or electronic transfer or may be made via a State or political subdivision "Purchasing Card" with no additional charge.

9. Administrative Fee:

Without affecting the approved Product or Service prices or discounts specified in the Master Contract No. 05316, the State of Iowa shall be entitled to receive a one percent (1.00%) administrative fee on all sales made within the State of Iowa against this agreement. The administration fee due to the State of Iowa shall be paid quarterly by Contractor directly to the State, made payable to the "Iowa Department of Administrative Services – Central Procurement".

- 10. <u>Quarterly Sales Report</u>: The Contractor shall provide the Participating Entity with quarterly sales reports which contain the following fields:
 - Purchasing Entity Name
 - Purchase Date
 - Line Item Description
 - Total Dollars Per Line Item Sold
 - Total Dollars Sold Per Quarter

The report shall be sent to the current contract manager at the Participating Entity within 45 days after the quarter ends. Quarters end on March 31, June 30, September 30, and December 31 annually.
